5. **New Business item (d) has been moved up the agenda for the connivance of our guest P. Reamer**
 - P. Reamer handed out literature on the name change of CSUH to CSUEB.
 - He requested the assistance of the HYC to stand out on Harder and Carlos Bee Roads on June 10th and help pass out hand out and hold signs protesting against the name change of the University.
 - Adv. Saad wanted to know what other groups were being approached to assist in this project.
 - P. Reamer said that every City Commission, Mayor and all City Council Members were being approached.
 - P. Reamer wants to come back to the HYC meeting in May to update the mission.
 - Adv. Saad will check with P. Reamer and see what exactly he wants the HYC to do in this plight.
 - Commissions agreed to have Adv. Saad check with P. Reamer and report back the HYC.

 - A. **Team Reports**

 - Cmr. Prentiss passed out a sign up sheet for the Relay for Life event at CSUH.
 - Cmr. Prentiss would like to host a youth symposium in the Summer of 06 or event the fall of 06**Research and Information**
 - Cmr. Keefer reports that due to lack of support for the other Commissioners, the HYC website will not meet their Aprils deadline. More participation needs to occur in order to get the content needed for the website.

 - Cmr. Bonilla – nothing to report on. He requested assistance on what needs to be done.
 - B. **HYC Website**
 - Cmr. Bonilla needs input on what was gathered at the last meeting with Adv. Saad. At that meeting a HYC website content was established. A list of content ideas.
 - Adv. Martin suggested that the list be passed around and each Commissioner sigh up to what they can contribute information about.
 - Adv. Quan suggested that the website should read what already has been established.
 - It was suggested that the Commissioners take a shot at it and write what they can from the list and email it to Adv. Saad.
6. **New Business**
 - A. **Relay for Life**

B. Tennyson Food Service Update

- Cmr. Shaminder reported that 660 students at Tennyson High School were surveyed and 125 seniors' surveys were returned. He is in the process of compiling the data from those surveys and will report the findings at a later date. He also reported that new menus are in the making for the cafeteria, offices and anywhere else the students are in the school.
- Cmr. Shaminder stated that each month is Harvest themed and will compile information on what the student's likes and dislikes are.
- The menu has also changed its white bread to whole wheat bread.
- The school is hosting a poster competition to see who can design a "Health" poster for the school.
- They are in the process of developing a survey for the other students.

C. South Hayward Bart/Mission Blvd. Plan

- Moved to the next meeting with a power point presentation planned.

D. P. Reamer CSUH name change

- Moved to the beginning of this meeting.

E. Printing HYC Recruitment materials

- Adv. Gerren passed out the H.U.S.D. printing price list to the Commissioners.
- A discussion was conducted on who should pick up the printing costs. H.U.S.D./H.A.R.D./City of Hayward?
- Adv. Saad agreed to have the City Clerk's office take care of the printing of the HYC Recruitment materials. She will then get them to Adv. Gerren for distribution within the schools.

F. Community Service Scholarships

- Adv. Saad reported that funds from the Forfeiture Asset Funds are earmarked to go directly to and for youths in Hayward. Forfeiture funds are collected from drug related seizures, i.e., cars, houses, misc.. items. Thus in turn, \$500.00 scholarships are made available for some qualified students in high school.
- The lead counselors at the High Schools will need to get applicants for these scholarships. Applicants would need to have volunteered a minimum of 100 hours within the City of Hayward boundaries.
- Scholarships are valid to attend culinary schools and a credited 2-4 colleges and schools.
- Each high school counselor will be given a poster and supply of application for their students.
- Adv. Saad requested that a Youth Commissioner be apart of the awards ceremony.

7. Advisor Reports

- Adv. Saad reports that large corporate donations came through and had a great turnout.
- R. Salinas passed out t-shirt designs for the Commissioners to choose as their future shirts.
- R. Salinas also requested a dollar amount not to exceed when ordering the shirts.
