 - A. **Volunteer Brochure**

They came up with the following ideas: P.A. announcements at the schools, school bulletins, utilize a schools television network system, homeroom announcements, movie theatre advertisements, college and parent night meetings, school rallies, invite youths to come to a H.Y.C. meeting, My Space Blogs, churches, restaurants and all over Union Landing in Union City.
 - Adv. Gerren stated that at their next meeting, they would discuss their priorities and where to recruit new H.Y.C. members.
 - Councilmember Dowling stated that the new Hayward theatre complex is scheduled to open in 2008 and that it would be a great idea for the H.Y.C. to advertise there.
 - Cmr. Faz wants the H.Y.C. to be involved in the Grand Opening of the Hayward Theatre.
 - Councilmember Dowling stated that the use of Myspace.com would be advantageous in publicizing the Hayward Youth Commission. Adv. Lange stated that the Hayward Area Recreation and Park District does not support the use of Myspace.com for advertisements. Councilmember Dowling stated that Myspace.com is used by countless youths and Adv. Lange should approach the H.A.R.D. Board of directors to allow H.A.R.D. to use Myspace.com for

advertising to youth and teens. Adv. Gerren stated that Myspace.com has a lot of interesting and positive projects on there.
