3. **Approval Of Minutes**

CMR. AGUILAR MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 5, 2007, CMR. FAKAVA SECONDED THE MOTION AND THE MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 5, 2007 WERE APPROVED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE.
4. **Public Comments:**
 - None
5. **Old Business**
 - A. **Volunteer Brochure**
 - Adv. Saad reported that everything is done and she is ready for the next project. The format will need to be changed before it goes to the printer this week. Adv. Saad is ready to move on to the Community Service Scholarships. Adv. Saad reported that Councilmember Bill Ward is donating \$500.00 to the Community Scholarship fund, thus bringing the total amount available to \$1,500.
 - Cmr., Aguilar and Andrade are on this committee project therefore they would need to publicize the scholarships that are available.
 - B. **Hayward Youth Commission Recruitment**
 - Adv. Gerren reported that she attended two H.U.S.D. High School counselors meetings and passed out the HYC Recruitment packets to each counselor. Adv. Gerren stated that there is another meeting is scheduled for March 28th. She would like to see a HYC member to attend. She also reported that at the last meeting a HYC representative were unable to attend.
 - C. **Teen Friendly Survey Follow Up**
 - Cmr. Martin reported that she had emailed the completed survey to each HYC. Some problems occurred while trying to open the file. Therefore Adv. Lange will email the survey to each HYC member in a PDF file. Cmr. Martin asked who had started their surveys.
 - Cmr. Aguilar reported that she began her survey.
 - Cmr. Martin re-iterated that by the next HYC meeting (April 2, 2007) each HYC member should be ready to report on his or her completed surveys.
6. **New Business**
 - A. **City of Hayward's "Keep Hayward Clean and Green" committee update.**
 - Cmr. Singh reported that he attended the meeting. He had a great time meeting all the other 39 committee members. Discussion on graffiti removal and cleaning up specific areas in Hayward were addressed. Thoughts of renting a bus to take a tour of the effected areas in Hayward were discussed as a means of becoming more aware of what needs to be done and where.
 - Cmr. Singh also stated that sub-committees would be developed to better focus on various areas. He will be attending the next meeting the week of March 12th.
 - Adv. Saad mentioned that if you visit the City of Hayward's website khcg.com, you may direct your complaints and reporting of graffiti, trash build up, abandoned and wrecked vehicles etc....
 - Cmr. Quan wanted to know if there was a designated place where graffiti artists can express themselves. If not, we should address that possibility.

- Cmr. Martin asked Cmr. Singh if that topic can be addressed at their next *Keep Hayward Green and Clean* meeting.
- Cmr. Singh stated that he would bring up that idea at their next meeting.

B. 2007-2008 Hayward Youth Commission Meetings

- Adv. Gerren addressed the HYC to see if their 2007-2008 meetings should be rescheduled for an earlier time. Instead of meeting at 7:30 p.m. maybe meet earlier starting July 2007.
- HYC decided to keep the meeting times at 7:30 p.m. for the 2007-2008 year.
- Adv. Gerren stated that the next HYC meeting (April 2, 2007) will be located at the H.U.S.D. Administrative Building. Also, the June meeting will be at the H.U.S.D. Administrative Building. The May 7th 2007 meeting will need to be at Chit Hall.

7. Announcements

- R. Salinas passed out information on the Union City Leisure Services Youth Summit.
- Cmr. Martin reminded that all the HYC members must have at least ten (10) surveys completed, typed and either paper clipped or stapled together by the next HYC meeting in May. She also stated that they can also email her the finished surveys.
- Adv. Lange added that the results of this survey in very important and will be a vital part in the reporting to the AFLAC committee at the end of the year.
- Adv. Saad announced that City manager J. Armas will be retiring and a reception will be held in his honor. This will give many people the opportunity to give J. Armas their best wishes. J. Armas spent 14 years as City Manager of Hayward and was instrumental in bringing in a shopping center, more housing and two new schools; Stonebrae and Burbank Elementary.
- Adv. Saad stated that by the December reception, a new City Manager would have been appointed.
