A. Clean and Green Committee Update

- Cmr. Singh reported that the bus tour took place last Saturday. The purpose of the bus tour was to travel around Hayward and see the areas most needing attentions. Cmr. Singh will follow up with the results of the tour and report back to the HYC at the next meeting.
- Councilmember Dowling reported that there have been five resignations from the Committee and are in the process of recruiting. He stated that he would like to see more HYC on this committee. The Committee meets two times a month on Thursdays and those meetings may meet once a month as time goes by. He also stated that since text messaging is popular among young adults that maybe they can text message the problem areas in Hayward for the Committee to check out rather than going to the website to report the problems.

B. Community Service Scholarship

- Cmr. Aguilar needs confirmations from the High Schools Counselors to be involved with the scholarship. Cmr. Rangel will do Hayward High, Cmr. Andrada will do Mt. Eden, Cmr. Aguilar will do Tennyson and Sant will do Moreau.
- Adv. Saad stated that the scholarships require at least 100 hours of community service completed in the City of Hayward. Also, the scholarships NOT dependent on grades.
- Adv. Saad stated that the Federal Government is not funding the matching funds but the City of Hayward will still move forward with the \$500.00.
- Adv. Saad would like to see an agenda item about how to raise funds for these scholarships in the future.
- Councilmember Dowling stated that letters to P. Stark and D. Feinstein informing them about the scholarships might be a good idea. C.C. the letters to City Council, H.A.R.D. and the H.U.S.D.
