a. CommPre/Community Prevention – Alfredo Coria

- Coalition has identified seven risk areas confronting Hayward Youth including Violence, School Safety, Nutrition, Physical Activity, Mental Illness, Tobacco, Alcohol & Drugs, and Sexual Activity;
- Data is compiled from California Healthy Kids Survey administered to Hayward youth;
- Many organizations or groups are actively working on one focused area of the seven risks, but the coalition of stakeholders are committed to work across agencies and organizations to address solutions;
- CommPre requests 1-2 HYC liaisons to join the coalition;
- Coalition members include Parents, Youth, Council members A. May & K. Dowling, HPD Chief, Mayor Sweeney, St. Rose Hospital, Kaiser Permanente, St. Rose Hospital, Tiburcio Vasquez Clinic;
- Coalition meetings are monthly on 2nd Thursday 5-6:30pm—Next Meeting (dinner incl.) @ SIAC Dec 11; Future locations determined by coalition members; Agenda includes Review of California Healthy Kids Survey Data, Creation of coalition structure, Establish coalition goals & work groups, Assist in Youth Strategic Master Plan- 5 yrs. Out; Coalition is not currently funded – future grant may be available for groups addressing community risks through partnerships
