6. Commissioner Update:

- B) Facilities Committee: This committee reported that they have reserved City Hall for this event. For the next meeting they will need the estimation of the rooms and supplies needed for each workshop from the Workshop Committee. From the whole committees they would also like know the budget they would like to spend on food and decoration. Asked that any and all special request for the rooms be submitted at the 3/19 meeting.
- C) Workshop Committee: This committee reported that they will change the workshop "Politics" to "Leadership" for better understanding and attraction to the participants. They proposed to have Mayor Sweeny to participate at the closing remarks of the summit as well as several council members for the Leadership workshop. For the workshop Jobs and Careers commissioners will address the issue of how to appropriately dress for an interview and they will invite several college students and/or college representatives to talk about the college systems and personal college experiences. The Health and Wellness Committee will bring a representative from St. Rose hospital to address the issues of sex education, addictions, healthy relationships, and self-wellness. All of these workshops will include a session of information chat and activities for participants to engage to.
