**b. City Wide Projects:** This group stated that we will be starting our tutoring program on January 14<sup>th</sup> from 4pm to 6pm at Burbank and Palma Ceia Elementary School. The program will be ending on March 25<sup>th</sup>. The tutoring services will be on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays of the month. Advisor Peña handed volunteer forms to the commissioners that are due at the next meeting, January 7<sup>th</sup>. We are eager to get our tutoring program started and looking forward to working with the students and giving back to our community.

**c. Field Trip-Facebook-Twitter:** The group followed up on our trip to Sacramento. They chose four dates for the commission to vote on, which were March 26, March 27, April 2, or April 3<sup>rd</sup>. Commissioner Beltran moved the date for March 26, and Commissioner Castro seconded; this date did not pass. Commissioner Faraj moved March 27, and Commissioner Guandique seconded; this date also did not pass. Commissioner Duran-Pereda moved April 2<sup>nd</sup>, and Commissioner Tauscher seconded; this date was approved. However, Commissioner Faraj brought up the point that this motion should be considered to be retracted due to the fact that there will not be a guarantee that we will be able to attend a session. Commissioner Beltran, then, moved to retract the April 2<sup>nd</sup> motion, and have a revote on April 3<sup>rd</sup>; Commissioner Castro seconded. The motion was passed with a unanimous vote. The field trip is now set on April 3<sup>rd</sup>. We are looking forward to further planning our field trip. In regards to our social media accounts, the commissioners of the group are getting started on this and looking forward to using social media to commercialize and promote our Youth Commission.
