1. Call to Order at 6:30PM by Vice Chair Commissioner Loche.
2. Pledge of allegiance.
3. Roll call led by Commissioner Kaur.

4. Approval of Old Minutes: Commissioner Beltran moved the approval of the December 16th minutes with the correction of Commissioner Loza and himself on the attendance as well with the grammatical correction of Alternative Gil's name. Commissioner Bautista seconded the motion and it was passed with a mayoral vote with one abstain from Commissioner West.
5. Public Comments: None.
6. Task Force Updates:
 - a. Keep Hayward Clean & Green: Commissioner Barcenas announced that the next cleanup event would be held at Shiloh Baptist Church in January 25th starting at 8:30AM.
 - b. Hayward Coalition for Healthy Youth: Commissioner Aguilar was not present at the meeting thus no update was given.
7. Planning:
 - a. Projects of the Year: The commissioners took this time to meet up in their assigned committees to continue with the process of planning on their prospected projects. After a while, they all gathered up once again and reported their progress.

In regards of the Youth Summit, with the guidance of Council member Francisco Zermeño, it was announced that due to printing arrangements the reproduction of the youth summit flyers have been extended until further notification. For the meantime, Commissioner Bautista will share with all commissioners the JPG file of the flyer so they can start sharing it in their social media networks. A press release is also planned to be created to promote the event. As well, through a message sent to Adviser Espinosa, Adviser Hathaway notified that she set up a Google Forum for this committee to communicate among each other their progress while being out of meeting but wanted for all commissioners to verify with her that they received the invitation. In addition, the committee finalized on what lunch they will be providing for their guests on the event. El

The commission will be providing water and granola bars to be given between the session breaks. For breakfast, the committee will try to get in touch with the local business Don Polvoron for a possible donation of sweet bread and orange juice. In regards to their participants, the committee will extend an invitation of participation to the superintendents and managers of each agency represented in the commission, as well as Mayor Sweeney, Aaron Horner from Soulciety, Project Eat, E4FC, among others. It is also contemplated to invite other political figures, such as Senator Corbett, Congressman Swalwell, and County Superintendent Del Valle, to speak during the entertainment and lunch time.

Regarding the Tutoring Project, with the guidance of Adviser Espinosa, it was announced that two (2) new applications for tutoring permission were approved and these commissioners will begin their tutoring sessions on the 15th. She will individually email the schedules of activities to the commissioners participating and will meet with site coordinators this week.

Last but not least, the committee in charge of the Volunteer Informative Book, with the guidance of Adviser Maine, informed that they will intercommunicate among each other to finalize on what exact information will be displayed on the book. With that in mind, they prospect to have a layout ready to present on the next meeting. As well, they have determined to synch the Youth Commission Facebook page with its Instagram account to keep its followers more easily updated. Adviser Maine also mentioned to send the renewed T-shirt designs to the commissioners via email.

Commissioner Castro also took this time to correct the prospected date for participation at TKBC. The date was changed to January 11 and despite the short notice 10 commissioners volunteered to participate. Alternative Gil mentioned that she would invite her AVID school group to also participate.
