- b. Quick Taskers Group: HYC will have 1-2 representatives from ACT Transit coming to HYC meeting. Commissioners will have the opportunity to discuss plans with AC Transit and to get constructive feedback in regards to their mission. The representatives will be arriving either on December 7th or during a January meeting. The group will be collecting information to promote the expansion of AC transit routes, and will try to collaborate with AC Transit to find better solutions for youth taking public transportation.
