In accordance with the provisions of California Elections Code Section 10260 and as directed by Resolution 14-008 and Resolution 14-028 of the Hayward City Council, the Alameda County Registrar of Voters, Tim Dupuis, has completed the official canvass of returns of the General Municipal Election, which was consolidated with the Statewide Direct Primary Election. RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF CANVASS  
BY THE CITY CLERK OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL  
ELECTION HELD JUNE 3, 2014, AND DECLARING THE  
RESULTS THEREOF

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2014, a General Municipal Election was duly held pursuant to law in the City of Hayward; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 14-008 and Resolution 14-028 the canvass of the returns of the General Municipal Election was authorized to be made by the Alameda County Registrar of Voters; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has canvassed the returns and has certified the results thereof to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the Council does hereby acknowledge receipt from the City Clerk of her certification of the canvass and hereby declares the results of the canvass as follows:

1. The total number of ballots cast in the General Municipal Election was 14185 ballots.
2. At said election there were three offices, one for Mayor and two for Council Members for four years to be filled.
3. The named persons were voted for at said election for the offices of Mayor and Council Member and received the number of votes, including votes by precinct and by absentee ballots, as outlined in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.
4. Barbara Halliday received the highest total of votes for the office of Mayor and was thereby elected Mayor of the City of Hayward.

- 5. Sara Lamnin and Marvin Peixoto received the highest total of votes for the offices of Council Member and were thereby elected to those offices.
- 6. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to sign and deliver to each of the aforesaid persons declared elected to the offices of Mayor and Council Member a certificate of election and to administer to each one the oath of office prescribed in the California Constitution.

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that;

- 7. At said election Measure C, a ballot measure relating to Use (Sales) Tax, was voted on and approved by the electorate. Votes in favor of the Measure totaled 9238. Votes opposed to the Measure totaled 4477, as set forth in the certification of the Alameda County Registrar of Voters, attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 8. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to enter a copy of this resolution with appropriate other entries upon the minutes of this City Council as a statement of the results of the election.

The Mayor Pro Tempore shall serve at the pleasure of the Council for the term of one year, and shall be elected and removed by the affirmative votes of at least five (5) members of Council.*


*In odd years, the Council Member with the most seniority as a Council Member, who has not previously served as Mayor Pro Tempore shall be elected. In the event two Council Members begin service in the same year, the Council Member with the highest number of votes will serve as Mayor Pro Tempore. (See City Council Minutes, 4/28/92)*

*Prior to being elected as Mayor Pro Tempore, a Council Member shall have served at least two years on the Council. The term of the Mayor Pro Tempore shall be based on the fiscal year of July 1 to June 30. (Resolution 98-120 and Council Minutes, 6/26/2001)*

*The Mayor Pro Tempore shall perform the duties of the Mayor during her/his absence or disability. (Sec. 605, City Charter)*

## **RECOMMENDATION**

That Council defines, agrees upon, and approves a process for filling the unexpired term of Council Member Barbara Halliday; and calls for a Special Election if appointment process is unsuccessful.

## **BACKGROUND**

The recent June 3, 2014 General Municipal Election encompassed two races for vacancies for positions on the Hayward City Council: Mayor and Council Member. Council Member Barbara Halliday ran for Mayor and won the election. Ms. Halliday takes her seat as Mayor effective July 8, 2014, which creates a two-year vacancy on the Council, as Ms. Halliday's term as Council Member runs from July 10, 2012 through the date the next Council is seated in early July 2016.

Section 501 of the Charter of the City of Hayward ("Vacancy in Elective Office") provides guidance when an elective office becomes vacant: "*A vacancy in an elective office shall be filled by appointment by the City Council, such appointee to hold office until the first Tuesday following the next General Municipal Election and until his successor is elected and qualified. At the next General Municipal Election following any such appointment, the person so elected shall serve for the remainder of any unexpired term.*

*No appointment to fill a vacancy in an elective office shall be made during such time prior to a General Municipal Election that nomination papers may be filed for candidates seeking office at said election.*

*In the event that Council shall fail to fill a vacancy by appointment within thirty days after such office shall have become vacant, it shall forthwith cause an election to be held to fill such vacancy. (AMENDED: STATS. 1964 CH. 41)"*

Council last experienced the need to engage in a similar process in 2006 upon the untimely death of Council Member Matt Jimenez shortly after his election to the City Council: a link to that report can be found [here](#). On June 10, 2014, staff presented a report to Council on a draft timeline for this process and a general outline of options. Council directed staff to return with a specific

recommended process at this meeting: a link to that report can be found [here](#). Council further suggested that the process be based on that used successfully in 2006.

**DISCUSSION**

There are two possible sequential steps to filling the current vacancy on Council as directed by Section 501 of the Charter: first, for Council to go through an appointment process; and second, to call for a special election if the appointment process is unsuccessful. In order to protect the second possible step for Council, the appointment process must either be concluded or declared unsuccessful and a formal call by Council for a “Special Municipal Election” well ahead of August 8, 2014, which is the final filing date for candidates in the upcoming November General Election.<sup>1</sup>

The timeline is very tight given that Council is traditionally “dark” in the month of August, with many Council Members and key staff taking long-planned vacations during that period. For reference, the following table identifies all Council meetings as currently planned and scheduled before the August recess, and their scheduled focus.

*Appointment Process and Timeline:* The 2006 process included an application period for those interested in serving on Council; a process whereby Council determined who and how many applicants they wanted to consider; a public interview process; and a public action to appoint the selected candidate. The selected candidate was seated that same night. With this in mind, a calendar of the appointment process would look something like the following, starting with the July 8 meeting installing the new Mayor and Council. The schedule is a mixture of regular and special meetings, with all but one being held on a Tuesday. A draft application for those interested in being considered for appointment to Council is attached as Attachment II for Council’s reference and approval. Possible steps in the appointment process based on the 2006 process are defined in Table 2 along with suggested timelines. If Council wants to avoid the Special Meeting on Thursday, July 17, a variation of the process/timeline might be as shown in Table 3.

*Special Election:* Should Council be unable to achieve a majority vote<sup>2</sup> to appoint someone, the Charter requires that the matter go to election. In order for Council to accomplish that in a timely and fiscally responsible manner, Council would have to call for a Special Municipal Election to be consolidated with the upcoming November General Election. In checking with the Alameda County Registrar of Voters, and consistent with the California Elections Code, the City must call for the Special Municipal Election at tonight’s meeting, July 8, 2014, in order to meet the public noticing requirements. Official filing for candidates opens July 14, 2014. These deadlines and the requirement that Council make a solid attempt to appoint a new member per the Charter before going to election puts pressure on the appointment timeline as captured in Table 2 and Table 3 above.

By approving the attached Resolution (Attachment I), Council is simply keeping their alternatives open and meeting the minimum requirements of the Charter, the State Elections Code, and the processes established by the Alameda County Registrar of Voters. Staff fully recognizes that it is Council’s intent to successfully pursue and complete the appointment process and encourages and supports Council in that effort. Clearly, it is not the intent of Council or staff to actually pursue the Special Election option, except in the most extreme circumstances.

With this in mind, the City Clerk will not formally file the Call for Special Election (Attachment I) with the County Registrar of Voters unless and until the appointment process fails by July 23, 2014. In the meantime, the public notice of a special election must be published in the local newspaper by July 14, 2014; and the formal filing period for candidates opens July 14, 2014. However, the City Clerk will devote only the minimum time and effort to the candidate filing process until such time as it is clear that the city must undergo a Special Election (i.e., unless the appointment process is unsuccessful and/or the closing date for filing – August 8, 2014 – is eminent.) Table 4 summarizes the key timelines applicable to the Special Municipal Election process.

Should Council not be successful in the appointment process and miss the deadline for consolidating with the November election, the option would remain to call for a Standalone Special Municipal Election, which would be at a time specified by Council after the November 2014 election. This would be very expensive and should be considered only as a last and remote possibility.

## **ECONOMIC AND FISCAL IMPACT**

There is no economic impact of the appointment process. There is potentially significant fiscal impact to the General Fund if Council defaults to the Special Municipal Election consolidated with the November election. Per the Alameda County Registrar of Voters, Hayward has 62,668 registered voters. The estimated cost per voter per the County Registrar for a Special Election consolidated with the November election is \$3 to \$5 per voter, which provides a possible cost range of \$188,044 - \$313,340.


Should Council choose to call for a Standalone Special Municipal Election, not consolidated with the November 2014 Statewide Election, the cost will be even greater: estimated at \$12 to \$15 per registered voter; or a \$7 to \$9 per registered voter for a Standalone All Vote-By-Mail Election.

## **NEXT STEPS**

As approved by Council, staff will implement and publicize the appointment process and timeline and take the minimal steps to protect the Special Municipal Election option.

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2014 a General Municipal Election was held in the City of Hayward; and

WHEREAS, as a result of that election, Council Member Barbara Halliday was elected Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Mayor-elect Halliday took her seat as Mayor on July 8, 2014 and in doing so formally vacated her seat as Council Member midterm; and

WHEREAS, Section 501 of the Charter of the City of Hayward provides guidance when an elective office becomes vacant; and

WHEREAS, the State Elections Code requires immediate publication of the intent to have a Special Municipal Election consolidated with the November General Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in accord with Sec 501 of the City Charter the City Council does hereby provide an appointment process to fill the two-year term vacancy created by the election of Council Member Halliday to Mayor effective July 8, 2014; and that the appointment process is as outlined in the staff report of July 8, 2014 entitled "Approval of Process for Filling a Two-Year City Council Vacancy" as such process may be amended through Council action taken on July 8, 2014; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council does hereby approve the City Clerk taking the necessary steps to protect the option of holding a Special Municipal Election consolidated with the November General Election should that be required; however, should the City Council successfully fill the vacancy by appointment pursuant to Section 501 of the City Charter, the City Clerk is directed to cease to take the actions noted below or to formally transmit a copy of this Resolution to the County Clerk of the County of Alameda and to so notify Council that:

1. The City Council does hereby call for and order a Special Municipal Election for the purpose of electing one Member of the City Council as set forth above.

2. The Board of Supervisors of Alameda County is hereby requested to order the consolidation of the Special Municipal Election of the City of Hayward with the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, insofar as the City is concerned, and to further provide that within the territory affected by said order of consolidation, to wit, the City of Hayward, the election precincts, polling places, and voting booths shall in every case be the same and there shall be only one set of election officers in each of said precincts, and to further provide that the candidates for the City Council hereinabove set forth shall be set forth in the form of ballot to be used at the General Election insofar as the same is held within the City. The Board of Supervisors of Alameda County is further requested to order the County Clerk and the Registrar of Voters to:
  - a. Verify signatures on nomination papers; and
  - b. Prepare and supply indices to precinct information; and
  - c. Provide voter registration information; and
  - d. Assist in election services as required in the conduct of this election; and
  - e. Provide services to complete the canvass of returns
  
3. The Board of Supervisors of Alameda County is hereby further authorized to canvass, or cause to be canvassed, as provided by law, the returns of the Special Municipal Election with respect to the votes cast for one Member of Council and to certify such canvass of the votes cast.
  
4. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify to the due adoption of this resolution and to transmit a copy thereof so certified to the County Clerk of the County of Alameda on July 23, 2014.
  
5. The City Council shall meet at a regular meeting to review the canvass of the returns of the Special Municipal Election and declare the results in December 2014.


