SUBJECT: **NOISE DEFLECTOR, EXPANSION OF INTERIOR RUN-UP AREA AND
ADDITIONAL RUNWAY EXIT TAXIWAY - APPROVAL OF PLANS AND
SPECIFICATIONS AND CALL FOR BIDS**

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications and call for bids to be received on February 17, 1998.

Background/Discussion:

This project will provide a noise deflector to contain aircraft noise, dust and fumes, expand the interior run-up area of runway 28L, and extend cross-taxiway "C" from runway 28L to the south-parallel taxiway "T." The taxiway extension will allow clearing the runway faster for safer landings.

The project is exempt under the National Environmental Policy Act and California Environmental Quality Act requirements, which allows for revisions to existing facilities for safety reasons where there will be negligible expansion of use and there is no individual or cumulative environmental impact.

Because the project is funded in part with a Federal Aviation Airport Improvement grant, the Federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program applies. Under the federal program, there is no separate category for Women Business Enterprises (WBE) and the single goal can be met with any combination of DBEs or WBEs. The goal for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation for the project has been established at 10 percent by City staff, based on the available subcontracting opportunities. In order to achieve this goal, approximately 53 percent of the available subcontracting would have to be performed by a DBEs or a WBEs.

Project Cost:

The estimated costs of the project are as follows:


Funding:

A total of \$285,000 is included under the Airport Capital Improvement Fund in the 1997/98 Capital Improvement Program. It is anticipated that the Federal Aviation Administration will reimburse the City approximately \$235,000, under an approved agreement with the City.

ADDITIONAL RUNWAY EXIT TAXIWAY**


