
Adopt an ordinance introduced by Council Member Henson at a meeting of the Hayward City Council on January 27, 1998, by the following vote:

PUBLIC NOTICE OF AN INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE HAYWARD MUNICIPAL CODE BY
AMENDING ARTICLE 5 THERETO RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF TAXICABS IN THE
CITY OF HAYWARD

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 6 of the Hayward Municipal Code is hereby amended by amending Article 5
thereto, to read in full as follows:

TAXICABS

- SEC. 6-5.01 CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE
- SEC. 6-5.02 CHANGES OF OPERATION
- SEC. 6-5.03 RATE SCHEDULE
- SEC. 6-5.04 RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR OPERATION
- SEC. 6-5.05 TESTING OF DRIVERS FOR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES AND ALCOHOL
- SEC. 6-5.06 DRIVER'S PERMIT
- SEC. 6-5.07 TAXIMETER
- SEC. 6-5.08 APPEALS

Section 2. SEVERANCE. Should any part of this ordinance be declared by a final decision by a
court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, invalid, or beyond the authority of the
City, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance, which shall continue
in full force and effect, provided that the remainder of the ordinance, absent the unexcised portion, can
be reasonably interpreted to give effect to the intentions of the City Council.

Section 3. In accordance with the provisions of Section 620 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall
become effective 30 days from and after the date of its adoption.

Introduced at a regular meeting of the Hayward City Council held January 27, 1998, the above entitled
ordinance was introduced by Council Member Henson.

This ordinance will be considered for adoption at the next meeting of the Hayward City Council, to be
held on February 10, at 8:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers, 777 B Street, Hayward, California.
