SUBJECT: **TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT (TDA) ARTICLE 3 FUNDS:  
WHEELCHAIR RAMPS - AUTHORIZATION TO FILE APPLICATION**

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Council authorize, by resolution, the filing of an application with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) for an allocation of TDA funds in fiscal year 1998/99, to construct wheelchair ramps at various locations throughout the City.

## Background/Discussion:

Each year TDA funds are made available to the cities in Alameda County for construction of bicycle paths, sidewalks, wheelchair ramps, and other pedestrian facilities. One of the conditions for MTC approval of TDA funding is the submittal of a resolution by the governing body stating that it has authorized the filing of an application for funds.

A Preliminary Grant Application for construction of wheelchair ramps at various locations for fiscal year 1998/99 (see Exhibit A) was submitted to the Alameda County Congestion Management Agency by City staff on February 13, 1998. The various ramp locations were selected in accordance with the Curb Ramp Guidelines established in the City's Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Transition Plan. Due to the success in prior year programs, the City is now able to begin completing all the intersections in specific neighborhoods. Concentrating on one area was chosen over doing a few locations in each neighborhood because it is more cost effective, since the contractor can mobilize in one area and does not have to spend as much time moving to each repair site. The allocation of \$83,973 in TDA funds for this project will be approved by the MTC upon receipt of the City's final project application. This final application, which is due by April 1, 1998, must include the City Council's resolution authorizing the filing of the application, as required by the MTC. MTC approval is expected in late June, 1998, with funds being available after July 1, 1998.



**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR AN ALLOCATION OF TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1998-99 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK WHEELCHAIR RAMPS**

WHEREAS, Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds are made available each year to cities in Alameda County for bicycle paths, sidewalks, wheelchair ramps, and other pedestrian facilities; and

WHEREAS, one of the conditions for Metropolitan Transportation Commission approval of the TDA funding is the submittal of a resolution by the governing body that it has authorized the filing of an application for funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute and file an appropriate application, together with all necessary supporting documents, with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission for an allocation of TDA funds for fiscal year 1998-99 for construction of sidewalk wheelchair ramps at various locations in the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission in conjunction with the filing of the application; and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission be requested to grant the allocation of funds as therein specified.
