SUBJECT: Rehabilitation of Taxiways "A," "B," and "F" Pavements and Signage at Hayward Executive Airport: Approval of Plans and Specifications and Call for Bids

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council approve the attached resolution that approves the plans and specifications and calls for bids to be received on June 27, 2000.

BACKGROUND:

This project will provide dig-out repair and overlay for taxiways "A," "B," and "F," new airfield electrical signs, and modifications to existing signs. Also, the emergency vehicle access road around the noise berm will be paved for all-weather access (see Exhibit A).

The project is exempt under the National Environmental Policy Act and California Environmental Quality Act, which allow for the addition of safety devices in conjunction with existing structures where there will be negligible expansion of use and there is no individual or cumulative environmental impact.

Because the project is funded in part with a Federal Aviation Airport Improvement grant, the Federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program applies. Under the federal program there is no separate category for Women Business Enterprises (WBE), and the single goal can be met with any combination of DBEs or WBEs. The goal for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation for the project had been established at 20 percent by City staff, based on available subcontracting opportunities.

PROJECT COSTS:

The estimated costs of the project are as follows:

FUNDING:

A total of \$1,275,000 is included under the Airport Capital Improvement Fund in the 1999/2000 and the proposed 2000/2001 Capital Improvement Program. It is anticipated that the Federal Aviation Administration will reimburse the City approximately \$1,147,000 under an approved agreement with the City.





RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR REHABILITATION OF TAXIWAYS "A," "B," AND "F" PAVEMENT, PROJECT NOS. 6811, 6812, AND 6817, AND RUNWAY AND TAXIWAY SIGNAGE, PROJECT NO. 6810, AT HAYWARD EXECUTIVE AIRPORT, AND CALL FOR BIDS

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward as follows:

1. That those certain plans and specifications for rehabilitation of taxiways "A," "B," and "F" Pavement, Project Nos. 6811, 6812, and 6817, and Runway and Taxiway Signage, Project No. 6810, at the Hayward Executive Airport, on file in the office of the City Clerk, are hereby adopted as the plans and specifications for the project; and
