SUBJECT: Arterial Pavement Rehabilitation – Phase I: Approval of Plans and Specifications and Call for Bids

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council approve the attached resolution that approves the plans and specifications for the Arterial Pavement Rehabilitation – Phase I and calls for bids to be received on August 1, 2000.

BACKGROUND:

On February 9, 1999, the City Council authorized staff to apply for \$3.6 million of federal funding for street overlays. The funding has been approved and will be implemented in two phases. This project phase consists of deep-lift asphalt concrete spot repairs, and grinding of existing pavement and pavement overlays on Industrial Parkway from **Ruus** Road to Mission Boulevard and on Tennyson Road from Hesperian Boulevard to Mission Boulevard, as shown on Exhibit A.

The project is categorically exempt under the “Minor Alteration of Existing Facilities” section of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. Additionally, the Local Assistance Branch of **Caltrans** concurs that the project is categorically excluded from the National Environmental Policy Act.

The federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program applies because the project is primarily funded with federal funds. Under the federal program, there is no separate category for Women Business Enterprises (WBE) and the single goal can be met with any combination of **DBEs** or **WBEs**. The established goal for this project is 9 percent, which is based on staff’s evaluation of available subcontracting opportunities for this project and an analysis as to which portion of the subcontracting would be reasonable to set aside for DBE participation.

PROJECT COSTS:

The estimated costs for the project are:

Inspection and Survey	100,000
Total	<u>\$1,822,000</u>

FUNDING:

The proposed 2000/2001 Capital Improvement Program Budget includes \$1,840,000 in the Street System Improvement Fund for this project. The City will be reimbursed 88.5 percent by federal funds.




