SUBJECT: FY 2000-01 Police Department Grant Matching Funds

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolutions.

BACKGROUND:

In recent years, the Hayward Police Department has been successful in receiving grants in support of various programs. The funding agencies typically require the acceptance of the grants be documented through approval of resolutions by the governing body. The accompanying resolutions are presented to you in compliance with funding requirements. The adopted budget assumed receipt of the funds.

The Community Crime Resistance Grant, administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (OCJP), will continue funding for one Police Sergeant position to coordinate crime prevention and intervention efforts in the downtown Redevelopment District. The goal of the grant is to coordinate government agencies, community-based organizations, and community groups toward specific crime prevention and intervention activities in the downtown. The project also focuses on the homeless population for expanded outreach programs as well as intervention and crime prevention strategies.

The Domestic Violence Grant, administered by OCJP, will continue funding for one full-time Police Officer and one half-time Family Counselor. The Police Officer follows up on every serious domestic violence incident and ensures that there is enough evidence to prosecute the case. The Family Counselor engages the victims in on-going individual counseling to help them end the cycle of violence and to go forward with prosecution. A third component is the Domestic Violence Advocate who is an employee of Shelter Against Violent Environments, but who works inside the Police Department to assist victims. During the first **two year-s of the** grant, we increased the number of suspects arrested for domestic violence and provided extensive support to the victims through both on-site counseling and referrals to community agencies for shelter and assistance.

The 1999 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant, administered by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, will continue funding of two School Resource Officers and provide additional funding for the final stages of our three-year I.S. Development Project. The School Resource Officers provide crime prevention, education and enforcement on Hayward school campuses. Prevention opportunities include classroom presentations, attendance at all major school events, and having informal dialogues with students on campus. Additional funding for our P.S. Development Project will go toward upgrades to our RMS/MIS system, creation of a remote access system for officers on the street and creating a departmental intranet.



WHEREAS, Resolution No. 00-087, a Resolution Approving the Budget off the City of Hayward for Fiscal Year 2000-2001, includes an appropriation of \$102,556 to account number 100-1828 to implement the Community Crime Resistance Program administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (OCJP);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City off Hayward hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to submit the grant proposal on behalf of the City of Hayward to the OCJP, and to sign and approve on behalf of the City of Hayward, the Grant Award Agreement, including any extensions thereof or amendments thereto or continuations thereof, in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Hayward agrees to provide matching funds in the amount of \$25,639 (20 percent of the total project cost of \$128,195) from the Narcotics Asset Forfeiture Account (277-1831) for the program fiscal year off July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Hayward acknowledges that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the Hayward Police Department and the City of Hayward; that the State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this Council.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 00-087, a Resolution Approving the Budget of the City of Hayward for Fiscal Year 2000-2001, includes an appropriation of \$271,142 to account number 100-1839 to implement the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program Administered by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau off Justice Assistance, and will continue funding of two School Resource Officers and provide additional funding for the final stages of the three-year I.S. Development Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Hayward agrees to provide matching funds in the amount of \$30,172 (10 percent of the total project cost of \$301,314) of which, \$7,241 will be provided from the Narcotics Asset Forfeiture Account (277-1831) while the Hayward Unified School District will provide \$22,931.
