SUBJECT: Request from Hayward Area Shoreline Planning Agency for Contributions to its 30th Anniversary Celebration

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council approve the attached resolution appropriating \$2,000 for the Hayward Area Shoreline Planning Agency.

DISCUSSION:

Next year will mark the 30th anniversary of the Hayward Area Shoreline Planning Agency, also known as HASPA. This multi-jurisdiction agency includes as members the Hayward Area Recreation and Park District, East Bay Regional Park District, Hayward Unified School District, San Lorenzo Unified School District, and the City of Hayward. Since approval off the original joint powers agreement in 1971, hundreds of acres have been acquired, enhanced and preserved along the Hayward area shoreline. In addition, thousands of citizens of all ages have been educated and come to understand the value of a healthy shoreline. To acknowledge these accomplishments, HASPA is planning an anniversary celebration to be held at the Shoreline Interpretive Center on Saturday, March 24, 2001.

HASPA does not have its own budget, consequently, each of the member agencies is being requested to contribute \$2,000 to underwrite the costs of the celebration. In addition to guest speakers, tours and refreshments, the day-long celebration will feature special exhibits highlighting HASPA's accomplishments. It is envisioned that these exhibits would be available to member agencies for educational and display purposes on a request basis. City staff is currently assisting in the gathering of historic photos and maps of the shoreline area and will be coordinating preparations for the celebration in its role as staff to HASPA. Contributions are requested by September 30, 2000, in order to facilitate planning for the event.

It is recommended that the City Council appropriate \$2,000 for the Hayward Area Shoreline Planning Agency in support of its 30th Anniversary Celebration.

Dear Hon. Dowling:

We are pleased to announce that the year 2001 is the 30th anniversary since the Hayward Area Shoreline Planning Agency (HASPA) was formed. In the 30 years, hundreds of acres have been acquired, enhanced, and preserved along the Hayward Area Shoreline. Through the process, the citizens of the area have been educated and understand the value of a healthy shoreline. It is because of the foresight of this multi-agency with the single purpose to preserve the shoreline that this accomplishment has been achieved. We would like to acknowledge these efforts by having a "HASPA 30th Anniversary" celebration.

We have planned this celebration for Saturday, March 24, 2000 at 10:00 a.m. at the Shoreline Interpretive Center. We estimate there will be several hundred visitors that day. As we discussed at our last meeting, since HASPA does not generate its own funds, we are asking for each member agency to contribute \$2,000 for this celebration. We will be also seeking funds from contractors and others who have benefited from the Shoreline acquisition and enhancements.

In order to appropriately celebrate this achievement, we are asking for each agency to gather appropriate historic photos and maps so that a display celebrating the 30 year HASPA history can be set up at the Shoreline Interpretive Center. We are planning to enlarge and mount with appropriate wording the photos and maps selected for this purpose. Once the celebration is completed the photos can be made available for other member agencies to use for educational purposes and for display in your jurisdiction.

The City of Hayward is the lead agency that will be coordinating this celebration. Therefore, we are asking if your agency would please send your monetary contribution (made payable to the City of Hayward) along with historic photos and maps of the Shoreline and any suggestions for the celebration to: Gary Calame, HASTAC, City of Hayward, 777 B Street, Hayward, CA 94541. We ask that the funds be submitted to the City of Hayward no later than September 30, 2000.
