The ordinance was introduced at the May 1st meeting of the City Council with the following vote:



**PUBLIC NOTICE OF AN INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO
THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY COUNCIL AND
THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE CALIFORNIA
PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an amendment to the contract between the City Council of the City of Hayward and the Board of Administration of the California Public Employee's Retirement System is hereby authorized, a copy of said amendment, marked "Exhibit A," and by such reference made a part hereof as though herein set out in full. (Exhibit A is available for review in the City Clerk's Office.)

Section 2. The Mayor of the City of Hayward is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the City.

Section 3. In accordance with the provisions of Section 620 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall become effective 30 days from and after the date of its adoption.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the date of its adoption, and prior to the expiration of 14 days from the passage thereof shall be published at least once in the Daily Review, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Hayward and thenceforth and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect.

Introduced at a regular meeting of the Hayward City Council held May 1, 2001, the above-entitled ordinance was introduced by Council Member Henson.

This ordinance will be considered for adoption at the next meeting of the Hayward City Council, to be held on May 22, at 8:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers, 777 B Street, Hayward, California. Copies of the full text of this ordinance are available for examination by the public in the Office of the City Clerk, 777 B Street, Hayward Public Main Library, 835 "C" Street, or the Weekes Branch Library, 27300 Patrick Avenue.
