SUBJECT: Authorization for the City Manager to Execute an Agreement with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control to Accept Funding for the Alcoholic Beverage Control Program

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Council adopt the attached resolution, which authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control to accept funding for the program, to appropriate \$100,000 to implement the program, and to add one Police Officer position.

BACKGROUND:

On May 21, 2001 the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control awarded the Hayward Police Department \$100,000 for the purpose of implementing an Alcoholic Beverage Control Program. The grant will fund one new Police Officer position. The grant also provides funds for equipment necessary to conduct undercover and decoy operations.


There are currently 239 alcoholic beverage establishments in the City of Hayward. This large number of establishments represents one of the highest concentrations of licensees in all of Alameda County. Many of these establishments have been the focus of crime and situations that create public nuisances. The large number of establishments also contributes significantly to a high number of alcohol related accidents and arrests.

The implementation of this program will include decoy/undercover operations, enforcement and education. The program will also contain a community awareness component, which will focus on youth and the dangers associated with the use of alcoholic beverages.

The Hayward Police Department will develop new partnerships, which will involve working closely with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, licensees, community-based groups, youth organizations and the City of Hayward Planning Department. We strongly believe that the implementation of this program will positively affect the quality of life in the City of Hayward.

The grant funding is for a one-year period (July 1, 2001 thru June 30, 2002). The grant funds 100% of employee services during this period but may be extended on a year-to-year basis.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL TO ACCEPT FUNDING FOR THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL PROGRAM; APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS; AND USE OF GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control has awarded the Hayward Police Department a \$100,000 grant for the purpose of implementing an Alcoholic Beverage Control Program which includes funding for one new Police Officer position and for the equipment necessary to conduct undercover and decoy operations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control to accept funding for the Alcoholic Beverage Control Program, in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council that Resolution No. 00-087, a Resolution Approving the Budget of the City of Hayward for Fiscal Year 2000-2001, is hereby amended by authorizing expenditure of funds received from the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control in the grant total amount of \$100,000, for the funding of one new Police Officer position and the equipment necessary to conduct undercover and decoy operations for a period of one year, from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the City of Hayward.
