SUBJECT: Water Main Replacement Project at Various Locations – Approval of Plans and Specifications and Call for Bids

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the Water Main Replacement Project at various locations and call for bids to be received on July 30, 2002.

BACKGROUND:

As part of the City's continuing program to maintain and upgrade its water system, staff has identified and selected a group of undersized or deteriorated and aging water mains for replacement. This year, an approximated 6,500 feet of 70-year-old water mains, lateral connection pipes, and fire hydrants at Laurel Avenue, Sunset Boulevard, Western Boulevard, Westfield Avenue, Russell Way, C Street, Sixth Street, and Ward Street were selected for replacement. This project will also upgrade the existing water system to provide adequate hydraulic capacity for desired fire flow in this northeastern region of the City.

Notices will be provided to residents, property owners and business owners who may be affected by the construction, to inform them of the nature and purpose of the work, potential impacts, and a City contact for additional information. A second notice will be provided when the contractor's work schedule is defined and specific dates for street closures can be established.

Staff has established a combined goal of 8 percent for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) and Women Owned Business Enterprise (WBE) participation for this project. The combined goal is limited due to the lack of available subcontracting opportunities.

Environmental Review:

The pipeline project is categorically exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The Public Resources Code states that CEQA does not apply to any project of less than one mile in length within a public street or highway or any other public right-of-way for the installation of a new pipeline or the maintenance, repair, restoration, reconditioning, replacement, removal, or demolition of an existing pipeline.

Funding:

A total of \$1,252,000 has been appropriated for the water main replacement project in the Water System Replacement Fund in the 2001-02 Capital Improvement Program.




