It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached Ordinance.





PUBLIC NOTICE OF AN INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDINANCE
BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 3 OF THE HAYWARD
MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE CITATIONS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 3.05 of Chapter 1, Article 3 of the Hayward Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1-3.05 LIABILITY FOR COSTS.

Section 2: Sections 1-3.100 through 1-3.200 are hereby added to Chapter 1, Article 3 of the Hayward Municipal Code to read as follows:

Section 3: Severance. Should any part of this ordinance be declared by a final decision by a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, invalid, or beyond the authority of the City, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect, provided that the remainder of the ordinance, absent the unexcised portion, can be reasonably interpreted to give effect to the intentions of the City Council.

Section 4. In accordance with the provisions of Section 620 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall become effective 30 days from and after the date of its adoption.

Introduced at a regular meeting of the Hayward City Council held March 25, 2003, the above-entitled ordinance was introduced by Council Member Hilson.

This ordinance will be considered for adoption at the next meeting of the Hayward City Council, to be held on April 1, at 8:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers, 777 B Street, Hayward, California.
