SUBJECT: Industrial Parkway Southwest Widening Project - Approval of Plans and Specifications and Call for Bids

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution that approves the plans and specifications for the Industrial Parkway Southwest Widening Project and calls for bids to be received May 18, 2004.

DISCUSSION:

This project will widen and improve 1,200 feet of Industrial Parkway Southwest, beginning at 700 feet from the Whipple Road intersection, along the eastside of the road, to 300 feet south of the existing bridge on the Alameda County Flood Control Channel (see Exhibit A). The project will provide an additional travel lane to alleviate the traffic congestion in the area. The project also includes construction of curb and gutter, a retaining wall with wrought iron railing, storm drainage facilities, relocation of existing fire hydrants, utilities joint poles, and installation of landscaping along the new median. The improvements are within the City's pre-existing right of way (see Exhibit B).

This federally funded project requires Caltrans review and authorization. Project approval from the Army Corps of Engineers, the Department of Fish and Game, and the Regional Water Quality Control Board were also obtained, since the project is adjacent to the Alameda County Flood Control channel.

The federal Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) program applies to this project. Under the federal program, there is no separate category for Women Owned Business Enterprise (WBE), and the goal can be met with any combination of DBEs or WBEs. The established goal for this project is 9 percent, which is based on staff's evaluation of available subcontracting opportunities for this project.

This project is categorically exempt under the Improvements to Public Facilities within the Existing Right of Way, Section 15301, Class 1(C) of the California Environmental Quality Act. A notice of exemption was filed with the County Clerk's office on May 28, 2003.

FUNDING:

The 2003-04 Capital Improvement Program includes a total of \$732,000 in the Street System Improvements Fund. Federal funding of \$458,000 will be reimbursed from the TEA-21 Program, and an additional \$30,000 will come from an existing developer deposit.







RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE INDUSTRIAL PARKWAY SOUTHWEST WIDENING PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 5199, AND CALL FOR BIDS

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward as follows:

1. That those certain plans and specifications for the Industrial Parkway Southwest Widening Project, Project No. 5199, on file in the office of the City Clerk, are hereby adopted as the plans and specifications for the project;
2. That sealed bids therefor will be received by the City Clerk's office at City Hall, 777 B Street, Hayward, California 94541, up to the hour of 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 18, 2004, and immediately thereafter publicly opened and declared by the City Clerk in the Public Works Conference Room, 4D, City Hall, Hayward, California;
