SUBJECT: Cinema Place Parking Structure: Approval of Addendum, Award of Contract, and Appropriation of Funds

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council/Redevelopment Agency adopt the attached resolutions that:

1. Approve Addendum No. 1, which makes modifications to the plans and specifications and extends the bid opening date;
2. Award the Cinema Place Parking Structure contract to West Bay Builders, Inc. of Novato, California, in the amount of \$6,430,000; and
3. Appropriate \$6,720,000 to complete the project.

BACKGROUND:

On April 4, 2006, the City Council/Redevelopment Agency approved the plans and specifications for the Cinema Place Parking Structure Project and called for bids to be received on May 16, 2006. During the bidding period, Addendum No.1 was issued to make modifications to the plans and specifications and extend the bid opening date.

The Cinema Place Parking Structure will be adjacent to the proposed theatre development and will be located on the corner of Foothill Boulevard and C Street. This project consists of three parking levels with central ramps, similar to the parking structure across the street from City Hall, and it will contain 244 parking spaces. Motorists would enter the parking structure from Foothill Boulevard or Theatre Alley, which can be accessed from B and C streets. The project will also include site improvements such as landscaping and irrigation, sidewalk repair and replacement, new driveway construction, and site drainage.

On July 20, 2004, the City Council approved the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring Program for this project. The Initial Study Checklist and Mitigated Negative Declaration were prepared in conformance with California Environmental Quality Act guidelines. It was determined that the proposed project, as conditioned to include the recommended mitigation measures, would not significantly impact the environment.

On June 1, 2006, two bids were received in the amounts of \$6,430,000 and \$6,570,000. West Bay Builders, Inc., of Novato, California, submitted the low bid in the amount of \$6,430,000,

which is 26 percent above the Engineer's Estimate of \$5,100,000. Zovich and Sons submitted the second low bid of \$6,570,000, which is approximately 29 percent above the Engineer's Estimate. The significant difference between the low bids and the Engineer's Estimate is a result of the higher-than-expected prices received for concrete, formwork, and steel, which together constitutes a major portion of the work. The design consultant has concurred that, in the present market, these prices are reasonable, especially since both bids were very close. Re-advertising would not likely result in any savings. All bid documents and licenses are in order, and staff recommends award of contract to the low bidder, West Bay Builders, Inc.

FUNDING:


Funding for this project is contained in the 2004 RDA Tax Allocations Bond Fund. Previously, the Agency appropriated \$310,000 for design of the project. An appropriation of \$6,720,000 from the Bond Fund is recommended to complete this project.





RESOLUTION APPROVING ADDENDUM NO. 1 AND
AWARDING CONTRACT TO WEST BAY BUILDERS, INC.
FOR THE CINEMA PLACE PARKING STRUCTURE
PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 5095

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2006, the City Council/Redevelopment Agency approved the plans and specifications for the Cinema Place Parking Structure Project, Project No. 5095, and called for bids to be received on May 16, 2006; and

WHEREAS, addendum No. 1 was added to make minor modifications to the plans and specifications, and extend the bid opening date to June 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2006, two bids were received in the amounts of \$6,430,000 and \$6,570,000; West Bay Builders, Inc., of Novato submitted the low bid in the amount of \$6,430,000, which is approximately 26 percent above the Engineer's Estimate of \$5,100,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that Addendum No. 1 is hereby approved and added as a part of the plans and specifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that West Bay Builders, Inc. is hereby awarded the contract for the Cinema Place Parking Structure Project, Project No. 5095, in accordance with the plans and specifications adopted therefor and on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Hayward, at and for the price named and stated in the bid of the hereinabove specified bidder, and all other bids are hereby rejected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract with West Bay Builders, Inc. in the name of and for and on behalf of the City of Hayward, in an amount not to exceed \$6,430,000, in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.
