SUBJECT: Sobriety Checkpoint Program for Law Enforcement Agencies

RECOMMENDATION:


It is recommended that Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with the Office of Traffic for the Sobriety Checkpoint Program for Local Enforcement Agencies; and appropriating \$38,532 for this purpose.

BACKGROUND:

On October 2, 2006, the Office of Traffic Safety through the UC Berkeley Traffic Safety Center (TSC) awarded the Hayward Police Department \$38,532 to implement a Sobriety Checkpoint Program. The program will be staffed on an overtime basis.

The goal of the Sobriety Checkpoint Program for Local Law Enforcement Agencies is to reduce the number of victims killed and injured in alcohol involved collisions in cities participating in this program. Law enforcement agencies will conduct sobriety checkpoints between October 1, 2006 and September 30, 2007. This time period encompasses two statewide and national mobilization periods, December 15, 2006 - January 3, 2007 and August 15, 2007 - September 3, 2007, as well as checkpoints outside of the mobilization periods as determined locally.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY TO ACCEPT FUNDING FOR THE SOBRIETY CHECKPOINT PROGRAM FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2006, the Office of Traffic Safety through the UC Berkeley Traffic Safety Center (TSC) awarded the Hayward Police Department \$38,532 to implement a Sobriety Checkpoint Program to be staffed on an overtime basis; and

WHEREAS, sobriety checkpoints will be conducted between October 1, 2006 and September 20, 2007.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with the Office of Traffic Safety to accept funding for the Sobriety Checkpoint Program, in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council that Resolution No. 06-080, a Resolution Approving the Budget of the City of Hayward for Fiscal Year 2006-2007, is hereby amended by authorizing expenditure of funds received from the Office of Traffic Safety in the total amount of \$38,532, for the funding of the Sobriety Checkpoint Program for a period of one year, from October 1, 2006, through September 30, 2007.
