**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Patricia Gowin thanked Mayor Sweeney and the Council for their efforts to keep Hayward streets safe and walk-able. She noted where she and her husband walk, in particular, along the green belt from Blanche Street to Fairway Street. She commented that there is no sidewalk between her daughter's home in Union City and her home in the Fairway Park neighborhood and asked if it was possible to have sidewalks installed over this dirt, rocky and uneven path.

Mayor Sweeney asked that she speak with Director of Public Works Bauman regarding this matter and asked that a response be provided in the weekly report.

Linda Bennett thanked all those involved who recently assisted in the clean-up of the San Lorenzo Creek. She also spoke on behalf of the Library Commission, requesting that the library budget be augmented rather than cut as its circulation counts continue to increase.

Council Member Quirk congratulated Daily Review reporter, Matt O'Brien, on his promotion.

Mayor Sweeney thanked all who participated in the Earth Day Celebration cleanup at Cypress and Harder Roads, including students from Cal State East Bay. He also commended those students, parents and teachers who participated in the clean-up at Mt. Eden High School.
