SUBJECT: Acceptance of the 2009 California Gang Reduction, Intervention and Prevention Program Grant

RECOMMENDATION

That Council approves and adopts the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to accept a California Gang Reduction, Intervention, and Prevention Program (Cal GRIP) Grant, and approving a supplemental appropriation of the grant award.

SUMMARY

The Hayward Police Department (HPD) has been awarded \$400,000 from the California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) to implement a two-year gang prevention, intervention, and reduction program entitled "Hayward Positive Alternatives for Youth" (HPAY).

As the lead agency, HPD will work collaboratively with the Hayward Unified School District (HUSD) and Associated Community Action Programs (ACAP) to provide educational, employment training and support services for youth considered at risk of gang involvement or already gang-involved. Emphasis will be placed on South Hayward communities.

BACKGROUND

This grant responds to Council's priorities and HPD's Strategic Plan. It funds new resources dedicated to our youth, their families, and the community at large. Specifically, over its two year term, it will pay for:

- One part-time Gang Violence Prevention Specialist (retired HPD officer)
- One part-time Family Counselor
- One part-time Family Counselor Intern
- Two part-time Employment & Training Specialists
- One part-time Student Services Coordinator
- One part-time Clerical Support Position
- Vocational training, and
- Opportunities for work experience and internships.

This grant requires a 100% "in-kind" match. We will meet this condition by documenting the contributions of existing staff in HPD, HUSD, and ACAP in support of the program's objectives.

FISCAL IMPACT


There is no net fiscal impact to this program. The in-kind match will be fulfilled using currently budgeted positions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council that Resolution No. 09-082, a resolution approving the budget of the City of Hayward for Fiscal Year 2009-2010, is hereby amended by authorizing expenditure of funds received from Cal EMA in the total amount of \$400,000 to implement the 2009 Gang Reduction, Intervention and Prevention Program Grant.
