**Did you know that the Day Labor Center has created long-standing full-time jobs with local Hayward businesses each year with companies like Case Compactors and Manada Roofing, Inc.**

**"There are hundreds of unemployed workers looking for work in Hayward each day."**

**Did you know that the Day Labor Center organizes day labor workers to provide more than \$20,000 worth of volunteer work every year in the City of Hayward.**

**"The City has been recognized and received rewards for their mural program."**

**Did you know that the Day Labor Center workers have painted the protective coat on many of the murals to protect them from graffiti damage.**

**"The City of Hayward wants to improve public safety in targeted areas."**

**Did you know that unlike other cities, the Day Labor Center and its workers have a strong working relationship with the Hayward Police Department; reporting crimes, painting over graffiti, and cooperating with the police to make it safe for children to walk to school.**

**"The City of Hayward meets regularly throughout the year implementing its Neighborhood Partnership Program."**

**Did you know that Day Labor Center volunteers have organized outreach efforts for several different neighborhoods in the City; going door to door, passing out the City flyer to invite neighbors to the meetings, getting signed commitments from residents to attend and making reminder calls to residents that request the reminder.**


**"The City of Hayward wants to develop school partnerships."**

**Did you know that the Day Labor Center has launched its Solar Initiatives Campaign that is a partnership with Solar Frontier (San Jose), Manada Roofing, Inc. (Hayward), and the Hayward Adult School, to have Hayward residents and businesses convert to solar energy; create jobs and on-the-job-training opportunities for Hayward residents; and, improve the carbon footprint of the City of Hayward.**
