




Bay Area Regional Interoperability Communication System (BayRICS)

The Bay Area Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) was created in 2006 from the three established Bay Area UASI's. Incorporating ten Bay Area Counties and three core cities of San Francisco, Oakland, and San Jose. The Governing Board is comprised of the three core cities along with Alameda and Santa Clara Counties.



Tier 1 UASI as designated by DHS formed 2006. The board voting structure is one vote each to City of San Jose, City of Oakland, Alameda County, Santa Clara County and two votes for San Francisco (one County, one City) for a total of six votes.



Bay Area Regional Interoperability Communication System (BayRICS) UASI Strategic Plan

Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System (BayRICS) vision was established by the UASI through the creation of a strategic plan with the goal of providing voice and data interoperability throughout the Bay Area region. There are several groups formed under BayRICS to address policy and technical issues that are currently meeting to formulate set agreements.



Regional Communications and Interoperability Initiatives November 2011



BayRICS will build upon capabilities of the county-based Regional Communications Systems (RCS) linked together providing Bay Area wide roaming for first responders. Each RCS are an entity unto themselves with individual governing authority to structure internal policies and procedures.
